A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to law enforcement policies regarding the issuance of
- 3 citations for misdemeanors punishable by fine only and to a
- 4 limitation on the authority to arrest a person for certain
- 5 fine-only misdemeanors.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 8 amended by adding Article 2.1309 to read as follows:
- 9 Art. 2.1309. CITE AND RELEASE POLICY. (a) In this article,
- 10 "law enforcement agency" means an agency of the state or an agency
- 11 of a political subdivision of the state authorized by law to employ
- 12 peace officers.
- 13 (b) The Bill Blackwood Law Enforcement Management Institute
- 14 of Texas, in collaboration with law enforcement agencies, law
- 15 enforcement associations, law enforcement training experts, and
- 16 community organizations engaged in the development of law
- 17 enforcement policy, shall publish a written model policy regarding
- 18 the issuance of citations for misdemeanor offenses, including
- 19 traffic offenses, that are punishable by fine only. The policy must
- 20 provide a procedure for a peace officer, on a person's presentation
- 21 of appropriate identification, to verify the person's identity and
- 22 <u>issue</u> a citation to the person. The policy must comply with
- 23 Articles 14.01, 14.03, and 14.06 of this code and Sections 543.001
- 24 and 543.004, Transportation Code.

- 1 (c) Each law enforcement agency shall adopt a written policy
- 2 regarding the issuance of citations for misdemeanor offenses,
- 3 including traffic offenses, that are punishable by fine only. The
- 4 policy must meet the requirements for the model policy described by
- 5 Subsection (b). A law enforcement agency may adopt the model policy
- 6 published by the Bill Blackwood Law Enforcement Management
- 7 Institute of Texas under Subsection (b).
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 543.001, Transportation Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- Sec. 543.001. ARREST WITHOUT WARRANT AUTHORIZED. Any peace
- 11 officer may arrest without warrant a person found committing a
- 12 violation of this subtitle, other than a person found only
- 13 committing one or more misdemeanors punishable by fine only.
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 543.004(a), Transportation Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 (a) An officer shall issue a written notice to appear if:
- 17 (1) the offense charged is a misdemeanor under this
- 18 subtitle that is punishable by fine only[+
- 19 [(A) speeding;
- [(B) the use of a wireless communication device
- 21 under Section 545.4251; or
- [(C) a violation of the open container law,
- 23 Section 49.031, Penal Code]; and
- 24 (2) the person makes a written promise to appear in
- 25 court as provided by Section 543.005.
- SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 27 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An

- 1 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 2 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 4 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 5 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 6 SECTION 5. (a) Not later than January 1, 2024, the Bill
- 7 Blackwood Law Enforcement Management Institute of Texas shall
- 8 publish the model policy required by Article 2.1309(b), Code of
- 9 Criminal Procedure, as added by this Act.
- 10 (b) Not later than March 1, 2024, each law enforcement
- 11 agency in this state shall adopt the policy required by Article
- 12 2.1309(c), Code of Criminal Procedure, as added by this Act.
- 13 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
