- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Health and Human Services Commission
- 6 with the assistance of the Texas Workforce Commission shall conduct
- 7 a study regarding the cost of child care in this state in comparison
- 8 to wages. The study must:
- 9 (1) examine:
- 10 (A) past trends in child-care costs in comparison
- 11 to past wages;

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- 12 (B) current trends in child-care costs in
- 13 comparison to current wages;
- 14 (C) future trends in child-care costs, including
- 15 projected costs for child care for each of the next 10 years and
- 16 projected future wages for each of the next 10 years; and
- 17 (D) expansion or stabilization of social service
- 18 programs over the periods provided in this subdivision; and
- 19 (2) compare the data described in Subdivision (1) of
- 20 this subsection for single-parent and two-parent households.
- (b) Not later than September 1, 2024, the Health and Human
- 22 Services Commission shall report the results of the study conducted
- 23 under Subsection (a) of this section to the governor, the
- 24 lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of representatives,

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- 1 and each legislative standing committee with jurisdiction over
- 2 child-care facilities.
- 3 (c) This section expires September 1, 2025.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
