## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to cemeteries in certain municipalities.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 711.008(g-1), Health and Safety Code, is

5 amended to read as follows:

6 (g-1) Not later than September 1, 2026 [2020], a nonprofit
7 organization may file a written application with the governing body
8 of a municipality to establish or use a cemetery located inside the

9 boundaries of the municipality. The municipality by ordinance shall

10 prescribe the information to be included in the application. The

11 governing body by ordinance may authorize the establishment or use

12 of a cemetery located inside the boundaries of the municipality if

14 establishment or use of the cemetery does not adversely affect

the municipality determines and states in the ordinance that the

15 public health, safety, and welfare. This subsection applies only to

16 a municipality that is wholly or partly located in a county with a

17 population of more than 3.3 million.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
