- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 54.04, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Subsection (s) to read as follows:
- 8 (s) If the judge orders a disposition under this section
- 9 <u>sentencing a person to commitment in the Texas Juvenile Justice</u>
- 10 Department, the department shall accept custody of the person not
- 11 later than the 30th day after the date on which the judge signs the
- 12 disposition order committing the person to the department.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act applies to a person who is sentenced to
- 14 commitment in the Texas Juvenile Justice Department on or after the
- 15 effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the conduct for
- 16 which the person was sentenced occurred before, on, or after the
- 17 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
