## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to a waiver of the requirement for the performance of an
- 3 adoption evaluation in certain suits for adoption.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 107.153, Family Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (e) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), the [The] court
- 9 shall order the performance of an adoption evaluation to evaluate
- 10 each party who requests termination of the parent-child
- 11 relationship or an adoption in a suit for:
- 12 (1) termination of the parent-child relationship in
- 13 which a person other than a parent may be appointed managing
- 14 conservator of a child; or
- 15 (2) an adoption.
- 16 <u>(a-1)</u> In a suit for adoption that is uncontested, the court
- 17 may waive the requirement under Subsection (a) for the performance
- 18 of an adoption evaluation of the prospective adoptive parent if:
- 19 (1) the prospective adoptive parent is a stepparent of
- 20 the child; and
- 21 (2) the court has reviewed investigative records of
- 22 the department and any criminal history record information
- 23 maintained by the Department of Public Safety relating to the
- 24 prospective adoptive parent.

- 1 (e) The costs of <u>conducting</u> an adoption evaluation <u>required</u>
- 2 under <u>Subsection</u> (a) or reviewing investigative records of the
- 3 department and criminal history record information maintained by
- 4 the Department of Public Safety under Subsection (a-1), as
- 5 <u>applicable</u>, [this section] shall be paid by the prospective
- 6 adoptive parent.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 162.003, Family Code, is amended to read
- 8 as follows:
- 9 Sec. 162.003. ADOPTION EVALUATION. In a suit for adoption,
- 10 an adoption evaluation must be conducted as provided in Chapter
- 11 107, unless the court waives the requirement for the performance of
- 12 <u>an adoption evaluation under Section 107.153(a-1)</u>.
- 13 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a suit for adoption that is pending in trial court on the
- 15 effective date of this Act or filed on or after the effective date
- 16 of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
