10	jail on the procedures for identifying, documenting, and handling a
11	person who is potentially suicidal or has a mental health
12	<pre>condition;</pre>
13	(2) conduct and document mental health screenings
14	during the intake process;
15	(3) house in a cell with cameras any person who is
16	identified as potentially suicidal;
17	(4) regularly check on each person described by
18	Subdivision (3); and
19	(5) report to the attorney general, in the manner
20	prescribed by the attorney general, any incident involving the
21	suicide or attempted suicide of a person confined in the jail not
22	later than 48 hours after the incident.
23	(b) The attorney general may use the information reported
