5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 12, Penal Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 12.502 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 12.502. PENALTY IF OFFENSE COMMITTED IN PUBLIC
8	TRANSPORTATION VEHICLE. (a) Subject to Subsection (c), the
9	punishment for an offense described by Subsection (b) is increased
10	to the punishment prescribed for the next higher category of
11	offense if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the offense
12	was committed in a vehicle operated by an authority created under
13	Chapter 451, 452, 453, 457, 458, or 460, Transportation Code.
14	(b) The increase in punishment authorized by this section
15	applies only to an offense under Chapter 21, 22, or 29.
16	(c) If an offense described by Subsection (b) is punishable
17	as a Class A misdemeanor, the minimum term of confinement for the
18	offense is increased to 180 days. If an offense described by
19	Subsection (b) is punishable as a felony of the first degree, the
20	punishment for that offense may not be increased under this
21	section.
22	(d) For the purposes of this section, "vehicle" means a bus,
23	a railcar, rolling stock, or another vehicle used by the public for
24	mass transit purposes.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
