- 2 relating to the seizure of firearms during the emergency detention
- 3 of certain persons who may have a mental illness.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 573.001(h), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (h) A peace officer who takes a person into custody under
- 8 Subsection (a) may immediately seize any firearm found in
- 9 possession of the person or found in plain sight and readily
- 10 <u>accessible to the person</u>. After seizing a firearm under this
- 11 subsection, the peace officer shall comply with the requirements of
- 12 Article 18.191, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an apprehension for an emergency detention that occurs on or
- 15 after the effective date of this Act. An apprehension for emergency
- 16 detention that occurs before the effective date of this Act is
- 17 governed by the law in effect on the date the apprehension for
- 18 emergency detention occurred, and the former law is continued in
- 19 effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
