## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 562.110(e), Occupations Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(e) The board shall adopt rules regarding the use of a
7	telepharmacy system under this section, including:
8	(1) [the types of health care facilities at which a
9	telepharmacy system may be located under Subsection (d)(1), which
10	must include the following facilities:
11	[(A) a clinic designated as a rural health clinic
12	regulated under 42 U.S.C. Section 1395x(aa);
13	[(B) a health center as defined by 42 U.S.C.
14	Section 254b; and
15	[ <del>(C) a federally qualified health center as</del>
16	defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 1396d(1)(2)(B);
17	(2) the locations eligible to be licensed as remote
18	dispensing sites, which must include locations in medically
19	underserved areas, areas with a medically underserved population,
20	and health professional shortage areas determined by the United
21	States Department of Health and Human Services;
22	$[\frac{(3)}{3}]$ licensing and operating requirements for remote
23	dispensing sites, including:
24	(A) a requirement that a remote dispensing site

- 2 services at the remote dispensing site;
- 3 (B) a requirement that a provider pharmacy be
- 4 allowed to provide pharmacy services at not more than two remote
- 5 dispensing sites;
- 6 (C) [a requirement that a pharmacist employed by
- 7 a provider pharmacy make at least monthly on-site visits to a remote
- 8 dispensing site or more frequent visits if specified by board rule;

- 10 inventory of controlled substances at the remote dispensing site be
- 11 reconciled to the on-hand count of those controlled substances at
- 12 the site by a pharmacist employed by the provider pharmacy;

- 14 employed by a provider pharmacy be physically present at a remote
- 15 dispensing site when the pharmacist is providing services requiring
- 16 the physical presence of the pharmacist, including immunizations;
- (E)  $\left[\frac{F}{F}\right]$  a requirement that a remote dispensing
- 18 site be staffed by an on-site pharmacy technician who is under the
- 19 continuous supervision of a pharmacist employed by the provider
- 20 pharmacy;
- 21  $\underline{\text{(F)}}$  [\(\frac{\((\mathbf{C}\)\)}{\((\mathbf{C}\)\)}\)] a requirement that all pharmacy
- 22 technicians at a remote dispensing site be counted for the purpose
- 23 of establishing the pharmacist-pharmacy technician ratio of the
- 24 provider pharmacy, which, notwithstanding Section 568.006, may not
- 25 exceed three pharmacy technicians for each pharmacist providing
- 26 supervision;
- (G)  $\left[\frac{\text{(H)}}{\text{H}}\right]$  a requirement that, before working at a

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remote dispensing site, a pharmacy technician must:
