- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 542.003(b), Insurance Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) Any of the following acts by an insurer constitutes
- 8 unfair claim settlement practices:
- 9 (1) knowingly misrepresenting to a claimant pertinent
- 10 facts or policy provisions relating to coverage at issue;
- 11 (2) failing to acknowledge with reasonable promptness
- 12 pertinent communications relating to a claim arising under the
- 13 insurer's policy;
- 14 (3) failing to adopt and implement reasonable
- 15 standards for the prompt investigation of claims arising under the
- 16 insurer's policies;
- 17 (4) not attempting in good faith to effect a prompt,
- 18 fair, and equitable settlement of a claim submitted in which
- 19 liability has become reasonably clear;
- 20 (5) compelling a policyholder to institute a suit to
- 21 recover an amount due under a policy by offering substantially less
- 22 than the amount ultimately recovered in a suit brought by the
- 23 policyholder;
- 24 (6) compelling a policyholder to retain a public

- 2 offering less than the amount ultimately recovered in a settlement

- 7 determines by rule constitutes an unfair claim settlement practice.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 4102.104, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 9 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 10 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), an insurer shall pay
- 11 <u>a commission of a license holder for services provided to an insured</u>
- 12 <u>as a result of the insurer violating Chapter 541 or Section</u>
- 13 542.003(b). The payment required by this subsection is in addition
- 14 to any other payment required under other law.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 542.003, Insurance Code, as amended by
- 16 this Act, applies only to an offer made on or after the effective
- 17 date of this Act. An offer made before the effective date of this
- 18 Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
- 19 effective date of this Act, and that law continues in effect for
- 20 that purpose.
- SECTION 4. Section 4102.104(b-1), Insurance Code, as added
- 22 by this Act, applies only to services provided under a contract
- 23 between a public insurance adjuster and an insured entered into on
- 24 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 25 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
