- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.605, Texas Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.605. CONTINUING EDUCATION. (a) In this section,
- 8 the word "clerk" includes a county clerk, district clerk, or county
- 9 and district clerk.
- 10 (b) A clerk shall complete 20 hours of instruction regarding
- 11 the performance of the clerk's duties of office before the first
- 12 anniversary of the date the clerk assumes those duties. At least
- 13 one (1) hour of instruction must concern the proper selection of
- 14 petit and grand juries.
- 15 (c) After the first anniversary of the date a clerk assumes
- 16 the duties of office, the clerk must each calendar year complete 20
- 17 hours of continuing education courses. At least one (1) hour of
- 18 continuing education each calendar year must concern the proper
- 19 <u>selection of petit and grand juries.</u>
- 20 (d) A clerk may carry over from the current calendar year to
- 21 the following calendar year not more than 10 hours of completed
- 22 continuing education courses that exceed the number of hours of
- 23 completed continuing education courses required under Subsection
- 24 (c).
