- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 83, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 83.0025 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 83.0025. ENFORCEMENT OF TEMPORARY EX PARTE ORDER. A
- 8 temporary ex parte order rendered under this chapter is enforceable
- 9 to the same extent and in the same manner as a final protective
- 10 order rendered under Chapter 85.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 86.001(b), Family Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- (b) A law enforcement agency <u>shall</u> [may] enter a protective
- 14 order in the agency's computer records of outstanding warrants as
- 15 notice that the order has been issued and is currently in effect. On
- 16 receipt of notification by a clerk of court that the court has
- 17 vacated or dismissed an order, the law enforcement agency shall
- 18 remove the order from the agency's computer record of outstanding
- 19 warrants.
- SECTION 3. Section 86.0011(a), Family Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (a) On receipt of an original or modified protective order
- 23 from the clerk of the issuing court, or on receipt of information
- 24 pertaining to the date of confinement or imprisonment or date of

- 1 release of a person subject to the protective order, a law
- 2 enforcement agency shall immediately, but not later than the next
- 3 [third] business day after the date the order or information is
- 4 received, enter the information required by Section 411.042(b)(6),
- 5 Government Code, into the statewide law enforcement information
- 6 system maintained by the Department of Public Safety.
- 7 SECTION 4. Section 87.004(b), Family Code, is amended to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (b) The clerk of the court shall attach the notification of
- 10 change to the protective order and shall deliver a copy of the
- 11 notification to:
- 12 (1) the respondent by registered or certified mail as
- 13 provided by Rule 21a, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure; and
- 14 (2) any other person entitled to a copy of the order
- 15 under Section 85.042.
- SECTION 5. (a) Section 83.0025, Family Code, as added by
- 17 this Act, applies to a temporary ex parte protective order rendered
- 18 under Chapter 83, Family Code, regardless of whether the order was
- 19 rendered before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 (b) Sections 86.001(b) and 86.0011(a), Family Code, as
- 21 amended by this Act, apply only to information regarding a
- 22 protective order received by a law enforcement agency on or after
- 23 the effective date of this Act.
- (c) Section 87.004(b), Family Code, as amended by this Act,
- 25 applies only to a notification of change of address or telephone
- 26 number filed with the court on or after the effective date of this
- 27 Act.

1 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
