A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to sales and use tax exemptions for certain computers sold
- 3 during a limited period.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 151, Tax Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 151.3271 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 151.3271. CERTAIN COMPUTERS FOR LIMITED PERIOD.
- 8 (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Personal computer" means a laptop, desktop, tower
- 10 computer system, or other personal computer that includes a central
- 11 processing unit, random access memory, a storage device, a display
- 12 monitor, and a keyboard.
- 13 (2) "Smartphone" means a mobile telephone that
- 14 performs many of the functions of a computer, is typically operated
- 15 by use of a touchscreen, has Internet access capability, and has an
- 16 operating system capable of running downloaded applications.
- 17 (3) "Tablet computer" means a mobile computer designed
- 18 for general personal computing purposes that is primarily operated
- 19 by use of a touchscreen or stylus.
- 20 (b) The sale or storage, use, or other consumption of a
- 21 personal computer or tablet computer is exempted from the taxes
- 22 imposed by this chapter if the personal computer or tablet
- 23 computer:
- 24 (1) is purchased during the period described by

- 1 <u>Section 151.326(a)(2); and</u>
- 2 (2) has a sales price of \$500 or less.
- 3 (c) The exemption provided by this section does not apply to
- 4 <u>a smartphone</u>.
- 5 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act does not
- 6 affect tax liability accruing before the effective date of this
- 7 Act. That liability continues in effect as if this Act had not been
- 8 enacted, and the former law is continued in effect for the
- 9 collection of taxes due and for civil and criminal enforcement of
- 10 the liability for those taxes.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
