- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 1202.004, Government Code, is amended by
- 8 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 9 follows.
- 10 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the nonrefundable
- 11 examination fee required by this section is equal to the lesser of:
- 12 (1) one-tenth of one percent of the principal amount
- 13 of the public security to which the record of proceedings relates;
- 14 or
- 15 (2) \$50,000 [\$9,500].
- 16 (f) The revenue attributable to fees collected under this
- 17 section during a state fiscal biennium that is not otherwise
- 18 appropriated in the General Appropriations Act for that state
- 19 fiscal biennium may be appropriated to the attorney general only
- 20 for the purpose of administering victim-related services and sexual
- 21 <u>assault programs</u>.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 23 a record of proceedings submitted to the attorney general on or
- 24 after the effective date of this Act. A record of proceedings

- 1 submitted to the attorney general before the effective date of this
- 2 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the record was
- 3 submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 4 purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
