- 3 keeping a gambling place, and possession of a gambling device,

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 47.01(8), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (8) "Private <u>residence</u> [place]" means a <u>dwelling</u>
- 9 [place] to which the public does not have access, and excludes,
- 10 among other places, streets, highways, restaurants, taverns,
- 11 nightclubs, schools, hospitals, and the common areas of apartment
- 12 houses, hotels, motels, office buildings, transportation
- 13 facilities, and shops.
- SECTION 2. Section 47.02(b), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 15 as follows:
- 16 (b) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that:
- 17 (1) the actor engaged in gambling in a private
- 18 <u>residence</u> [place];
- 19 (2) no person received any economic benefit other than
- 20 personal winnings; and
- 21 (3) except for the advantage of skill or luck, the
- 22 risks of losing and the chances of winning were the same for all
- 23 participants.
- SECTION 3. Section 47.04(b), Penal Code, is amended to read

- 1 as follows:
- 2 (b) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
- 3 section that:
- 4 (1) the gambling occurred in a private residence
- 5 [<del>place</del>];
- 6 (2) no person received any economic benefit other than
- 7 personal winnings; and
- 8 (3) except for the advantage of skill or luck, the
- 9 risks of losing and the chances of winning were the same for all
- 10 participants.
- SECTION 4. Section 47.06(d), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 12 as follows:
- 13 (d) It is a defense to prosecution under Subsections (a) and
- 14 (c) that:
- 15 (1) the device, equipment, or paraphernalia is used
- 16 for or is intended for use in gambling that is to occur entirely in a
- 17 private residence [place];
- 18 (2) a person involved in the gambling does not receive
- 19 any economic benefit other than personal winnings; and
- 20 (3) except for the advantage of skill or luck, the
- 21 chance of winning is the same for all participants.
- SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 23 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 24 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 25 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 26 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 27 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of

- 1 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 2 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
