2	relating to the selection and reimbursement of certain persons
3	providing services required under a service plan filed by the
4	Department of Family and Protective Services.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 263, Family Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 263.1021 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 263.1021. SELECTION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF SERVICE
9	PROVIDER. (a) A parent who is required to complete a service plan
10	under this subchapter may obtain services from a qualified or
11	licensed provider selected by the parent.
12	(b) Services obtained from a provider selected under
13	Subsection (a):
14	(1) must be:
15	(A) designed to achieve the stated goals of the
16	service plan; and
17	(B) provided using an evidence-based program or
18	practice or a promising program or practice; and
19	(2) may be provided through an electronic
20	communication platform.
21	(c) A service provider selected by a parent shall certify in
22	writing whether the parent has satisfactorily completed the
23	required service.
24	(d) The department shall reimburse a service provider

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1	selected by the parent under Subsection (a) who is not under
2	contract with the department in an amount equal to the average cost
3	for the specific service from department contractors providing the
4	service in the region where the parent resides.
5	(e) The department shall adopt rules relating to the manner
6	in which providers are reimbursed for services provided under this
7	section.
8	(f) Not later than December 1, 2023, the department shall
9	adopt the rules required by Subsection (e). The department shall
10	convene a work group to assist the department in developing the
11	rules. This subsection expires September 1, 2024.
12	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
13	a suit filed by the Department of Family and Protective Services on
14	or after the effective date of this Act. A suit filed by the
15	department before that date is governed by the law in effect on the
16	date the suit was filed, and the former law is continued in effect
17	for that purpose.
18	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
