H.B. No. 872

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to a manufacturer's disclosure of ingredients and toxic
3 metals in lipstick and lip gloss.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 431, Health and Safety
6 Code, is amended by adding Section 431.143 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 431.143. MANUFACTURER DISCLOSURES: LIPSTICK AND LIP
8 GLOSS COSMETIC. The executive commissioner by rule shall require a
9 manufacturer that sells a lipstick or lip gloss cosmetic to
10 disclose on the manufacturer's Internet website and the cosmetic
11 label:

12 (1) any toxic metal, including lead, chromium,
13 cadmium, aluminum, and manganese, in the cosmetic, regardless of
14 whether the concentration of the metal in the cosmetic is less than
15 one percent; and

16 (2) a list of each ingredient in the cosmetic,
17 including a fragrance, flavor, and color additive.

18 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
19 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
20 Services Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
21 Section 431.143, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
