- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 104.008, Family Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a party is not
- 9 prohibited from using expert testimony to challenge the
- 10 qualifications of or methodology used by a person who has conducted
- 11 a custody evaluation relating to the child under Subchapter D,
- 12 <u>Chapter 107.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 14 a suit affecting the parent-child relationship that is filed on or
- 15 after the effective date of this Act. A suit affecting the
- 16 parent-child relationship filed before the effective date of this
- 17 Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the suit is filed,
- 18 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
