4	SECTION 1. Section 264.101, Family Code, is amended by
5	adding Subsection (a-3) to read as follows:
6	(a-3) In addition to the daily foster care reimbursement
7	rate paid to a foster parent under this section, the department
8	shall pay an additional amount equal to 40 percent of the daily
9	foster care reimbursement rate paid to the foster parent if the
10	<pre>foster parent:</pre>
11	(1) cares for a foster child who is 16 years of age or
12	younger; and
13	(2) has an adjusted household income that does not
14	exceed 150 percent of the current federal poverty guidelines for
15	the relevant household size.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
