To promote public 8 9 health, safety, and welfare, the commissioners court of a county with a population of more than 3.3 million by order may regulate the 10 <u>level of noise emanating from a residence</u> located in a residential 11 12 area in the unincorporated area of the county. 13 Sec. 240.062. CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A person commits an 14 offense if the person violates an order adopted under this 15 subchapter. (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor. 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 17
