10	SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1369, Insurance Code, is		
11	amended by adding Section 1369.0542 to read as follows:		
12	Sec. 1369.0542. EFFECT OF REDUCTIONS IN OUT-OF-POCKET		
13	EXPENSES ON COST SHARING. (a) This section applies only to a		
14	reduction in out-of-pocket expenses made by or on behalf of ar		
15	enrollee for a prescription drug covered by the enrollee's health		
16	benefit plan for which:		
17	(1) a generic equivalent does not exist;		
18	(2) a generic equivalent does exist but the enrollee		
19	has obtained access to the prescription drug under the enrollee's		
20	health benefit plan using:		
21	(A) a prior authorization process;		
22	(B) a step therapy protocol; or		
23	(C) the health benefit plan issuer's exceptions		
24	and appeals process;

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- 1 (3) an interchangeable biological product does not
- 2 exist; or
- 3 (4) an interchangeable biological product does exist
- 4 but the enrollee has obtained access to the prescription drug under
- 5 the enrollee's health benefit plan using:

- 7 <u>(B) a step therapy protocol; or</u>
- 8 (C) the health benefit plan issuer's exceptions

- 10 (b) An issuer of a health benefit plan that covers
- 11 prescription drugs or a pharmacy benefit manager shall apply any
- 12 third-party payment, financial assistance, discount, product
- 13 voucher, or other reduction in out-of-pocket expenses made by or on
- 14 behalf of an enrollee for a prescription drug to the enrollee's
- 15 deductible, copayment, cost-sharing responsibility, or
- 16 <u>out-of-pocket maximum applicable to health benefits under the</u>
- 17 enrollee's plan.
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 1369.0542, Insurance Code, as added by
- 19 this Act, applies only to a health benefit plan that is delivered,
- 20 issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2024. A
- 21 health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 22 before January 1, 2024, is governed by the law as it existed
- 23 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
