6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 531.02485 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 531.02485. REQUIRED REVIEW OF CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD
9	INFORMATION FOR CERTAIN RESIDENTIAL CAREGIVERS. (a) In this
10	section, "residential caregiver" means an individual who provides,
11	through a group home or other residential facility licensed by or
12	operated under the authority of the commission, including a group
13	home or facility licensed or operated under a Section 1915(c)
14	waiver program, community-based residential care services:
15	(1) to not more than four individuals with an
16	intellectual or developmental disability at any time; and
17	(2) at a residence other than the home of an individual
18	described by Subdivision (1).
19	(b) The commission shall review state and federal criminal
20	history record information and obtain electronic updates from the

authorization issued by the commission.

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Department of Public Safety of arrests and convictions for each

residential caregiver who holds a license or other operational

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- 1 offense described by Section 250.006, Health and Safety Code, may
- 2 not provide direct care to an individual with an intellectual or
- 3 <u>developmental disability</u>. A residential caregiver who violates
- 4 this subsection is subject to disciplinary action by the
- 5 <u>commission</u>.
- 6 (d) The commission shall disenroll from participation in
- 7 Medicaid a residential caregiver who has been convicted of an
- 8 offense described by Section 250.006, Health and Safety Code.
- 9 (e) The executive commissioner shall adopt rules necessary
- 10 to implement this section.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
