- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1103.053, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) or (c), a
- 10 beneficiary or owner of a life insurance policy who is designated in
- 11 accordance with this subchapter or an entity to which a life
- 12 insurance policy or an interest, benefit, right, or title in a life
- 13 insurance policy is transferred or assigned in accordance with this
- 14 subchapter has, at all times after the designation, an insurable
- 15 interest in the life of the individual who is insured under the
- 16 policy.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> A person providing care to an individual with a
- 18 disability, including an intellectual disability, at a state
- 19 supported living center, as defined by Section 531.002, Health and
- 20 Safety Code, an assisted living facility licensed under Chapter
- 21 247, Health and Safety Code, an intermediate care facility licensed
- 22 under Chapter 252, Health and Safety Code, or a group home, as
- 23 defined by Section 591.003, Health and Safety Code, does not
- 24 directly or indirectly have an insurable interest in the life of an

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- 1 <u>individual unless the person is a relative of the individual.</u>
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 1103.053(c), Insurance Code, as added by
- 3 this Act, applies only to an insurance policy delivered, issued for
- 4 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2024.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
