- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 32, Election Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 32.116 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.116. REQUIRED TRAINING RELATED TO ACCEPTING VOTERS
- 8 WHO IDENTIFY AS TRANSGENDER. Each program, standard, or material
- 9 for any training developed under this subchapter must include:
- 10 (1) guidance for election workers to accept photo
- 11 identification that may not align with a person's presenting gender
- 12 expression or identity; and
- 13 (2) information about voters who identify as
- 14 transgender and their historical disenfranchisement.
- SECTION 2. Section 63.0101, Election Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) An indication of gender on a form of identification
- 18 <u>described</u> by this section that does not align with the gender
- 19 expression or identity of the person seeking to vote does not
- 20 invalidate the form of identification for the purpose of accepting
- 21 <u>a voter for voting.</u>
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
