- 4 SECTION 1. Section 157.021(a), Local Government Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) In a county with a population of 350,000 [355,000] or
- 7 more, the commissioners court may adopt and enforce uniform rules
- 8 on the hours of work of department heads, assistants, deputies, and
- 9 other employees whose compensation is set or approved by the court.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
