9	impose a tax as provided by Subsection (a).
10	SECTION 2. Section 352.003, Tax Code, is amended by adding
11	Subsection (bb) to read as follows:
12	(bb) The tax rate in a county authorized to impose the tax
13	under Section 352.002(w) may not exceed two percent of the price
14	paid for a room in a hotel.
15	SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 352, Tax Code, is amended
16	by adding Section 352.115 to read as follows:
17	Sec. 352.115. USE OF REVENUE: CERTAIN COUNTIES CONTAINING
18	NATIONAL GRASSLAND. In addition to the purposes authorized by this
19	chapter, the revenue from a tax imposed under this chapter by a
20	county authorized to impose the tax under Section 352.002(w) may be
21	used for:
22	(1) the purposes described by Section 352.112; and
23	(2) historical preservation and restoration.
24	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
