4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 28.028 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 28.028. TEXAS STATE SEAL OF BILINGUALISM AND
8	BILITERACY. (a) In this section, "seal" means the Texas State Seal
9	of Bilingualism and Biliteracy established under Subsection (b).
10	(b) The agency shall establish a seal to recognize high
11	school graduates who have attained a high level of proficiency in
12	comprehending, speaking, reading, and writing in both English and a
13	language other than English.
14	(c) The agency, in consultation with appropriate
15	stakeholders, shall:
16	(1) determine minimum requirements for earning the
17	seal, which:
18	(A) must be sufficiently rigorous to indicate to
19	an employer or postsecondary institution that a student who has
20	earned the seal is biliterate;
21	(B) may include completion of a project,
22	activity, or portfolio; and
23	(C) may not condition receipt of the seal on an
24	examination created for that purpose; and

(2) prepare and deliver to each school district an 1 2 insignia that can be affixed or stamped on the diploma of and adopt a designation to be included on the transcript of a student who has 3 satisfied requirements for earning the seal. 4 5 (d) Each school district shall: 6 (1) maintain appropriate records to identify students 7 who have earned the seal; and 8 (2) for each student who has satisfied requirements 9 for earning the seal: 10 (A) affix the seal's insignia to the student's 11 diploma; and 12 (B) include in the student's transcript that the 13 student earned the seal. 14 (e) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to 15 administer this section. 16 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 17 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 22
