## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the creation of a low-interest loan program for entrepreneurs with physical or mental disabilities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Title 4, Labor Code, is amended by adding 5 Subtitle D to read as follows: 6 SUBTITLE D. ENTREPRENEURSHIP LOANS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES 7 CHAPTER 375. ENTREPRENEURSHIP LOANS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES 8 9 Sec. 375.001. ENTREPRENEURSHIP LOANS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES. (a) In this section: 10 (1) "Commission" <u>means the</u> Texas Workforce 11 12 Commission. 13 (2) "Disability" means, with respect to an individual, 14 a mental or physical impairment that substantially limits at least one major life activity of that individual. 15 (b) The commission shall establish and administer a 16 low-interest loan program to support entrepreneurship among 17 persons with physical and mental disabilities. 18 (c) The commission may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and 19 donations from public and private entities to use for the purposes 20 of this section. 21 (d) The commission shall adopt rules as necessary to 22 23 establish and administer the loan program established under this 24 section.

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SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2024, the Texas
Workforce Commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
Chapter 375, Labor Code, as added by this Act.

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4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
