- 4 SECTION 1. Section 130.168, Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 130.168. BLINN JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE AREA.
- 7 The service area of the Blinn College District includes the
- 8 territory within:
- 9 (1) Washington, Burleson, Brazos, Madison, Grimes,
- 10 and Waller <a href="Counties">Counties</a>];
- 11 (2) the Mumford, Hearne, and Franklin Independent
- 12 School Districts [independent school districts] located in
- 13 Robertson County;
- 14 (3) Austin County, other than the territory within the
- 15 Wallis-Orchard Independent School District;
- 16 (4) the Milano and Gause <u>Independent School Districts</u>
- 17 [independent school districts] located in Milam County;
- 18 (5) the part of the Richards Independent School
- 19 District that is located in Walker and Montgomery Counties
- 20 [counties];
- 21 (6) the part of the Bryan Independent School District
- 22 that is located in Robertson County;
- 23 (7) Fayette County, other than the territory within
- 24 the Smithville Independent School District;

- 1 (8) Lee County, other than the territory within the
- 2 Elgin Independent School District; [and]
- 3 (9) the part of the Lexington Independent School
- 4 District that is located in Bastrop, Milam, and Williamson
- 5 Counties; and
- 6 (10) the part of the Waller Independent School
- 7 <u>District that is located in Harris County</u> [counties].
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
