1-24 relating to the service area of the Blinn Junior College District.
 1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-26 SECTION 1. Section 130.168, Education Code, is amended to
 1-27 read as follows:
 1-28 Sec. 130.168. BLINN JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE AREA.
 1-29 The service area of the Blinn College District includes the
 1-30 territory within:
 1-31 (1) Washington, Burleson, Brazos, Madison, Grimes,
 1-32 and Waller Counties [~~counties~~];
 1-33 (2) the Mumford, Hearne, and Franklin Independent
 1-34 School Districts [~~independent school districts~~] located in
 1-35 Robertson County;
 1-36 (3) Austin County, other than the territory within the
 1-37 Wallis-Orchard Independent School District;
 1-38 (4) the Milano and Gause Independent School Districts
 1-39 [~~independent school districts~~] located in Milam County;
 1-40 (5) the part of the Richards Independent School
 1-41 District that is located in Walker and Montgomery Counties
 1-42 [~~counties~~];
 1-43 (6) the part of the Bryan Independent School District
 1-44 that is located in Robertson County;
 1-45 (7) Fayette County, other than the territory within
 1-46 the Smithville Independent School District;
 1-47 (8) Lee County, other than the territory within the
 1-48 Elgin Independent School District; [~~and~~]
 1-49 (9) the part of the Lexington Independent School
 1-50 District that is located in Bastrop, Milam, and Williamson
 1-51 Counties; and
 1-52 (10) the part of the Waller Independent School
 1-53 District that is located in Harris County [~~counties~~].
 1-54 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-55 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-56 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-57 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-58 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
