A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to judicial statistics and other pertinent information,
- 3 including landlord and tenant dispute information, gathered by or
- 4 reported to the Texas Judicial Council and certain populous
- 5 counties.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 71.035, Government Code, is amended by
- 8 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1), (a-2), and
- 9 (a-3) to read as follows:
- 10 (a) The council shall gather judicial statistics and other
- 11 pertinent information, including monthly court activity statistics
- 12 for each trial court in this state, from the several state judges
- 13 and other court officials of this state.
- 14 <u>(a-1) The</u> [In addition, the] council shall implement a
- 15 monthly tracking system to ensure accountability for counties and
- 16 courts which participate in the statewide integrated system for
- 17 child support, medical support, and dental support enforcement
- 18 established under Section 231.0011, Family Code. As a duty of
- 19 office, the district clerks and county clerks serving the affected
- 20 courts shall report monthly such information as may be required by
- 21 the council, including, at a minimum, the time required to enforce
- 22 cases from date of delinquency, from date of filing, and from date
- 23 of service until date of disposition. Such information as is
- 24 necessary to complete the report and not directly within the

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- 1 control of the district or county clerk, such as date of
- 2 delinquency, shall be provided to the clerk by the child support
- 3 registry or by the enforcement agency providing Title IV-D
- 4 enforcement services in the court.
- 5 (a-2) A [The] monthly report required by Subsection (a) or
- 6 (a-1) must [shall] be transmitted to the Office of Court
- 7 Administration of the Texas Judicial System no later than the 20th
- 8 day of the month following the month reported, in the [such] form
- 9 and manner [as may be] prescribed by the office [Office of Court
- 10 Administration], which may include electronic data transfer. The
- 11 office shall publish the information for each court on the office's
- 12 public Internet website in a searchable format.
- 13 <u>(a-3)</u> In a county with a population greater than one
- 14 million, a court official for each court in the county shall submit
- 15 to the appropriate county official for publication on the county's
- 16 public Internet website a copy of each monthly report required
- 17 under Subsections (a) and (a-1) within the time required by
- 18 Subsection (a-2). The county shall publish the information for
- 19 each court on the county's Internet website in a searchable format
- 20 [Copies of such reports shall be maintained in the office of the
- 21 appropriate district or county clerk for a period of at least two
- 22 years and shall be available to the public for inspection and
- 23 reproduction].
- SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 71, Government Code, is
- 25 amended by adding Section 71.0354 to read as follows:
- 26 Sec. 71.0354. LANDLORD AND TENANT DISPUTE INFORMATION:
- 27 COURTS. (a) As a component of the official monthly report

- 1 submitted under Section 71.035, a court with jurisdiction over
- 2 landlord and tenant disputes shall report by category each case
- 3 filed in the court under Chapter 24, Property Code, or Title 8,
- 4 Property Code, including:
- 5 (1) eviction suits;
- 6 (2) suits involving the disconnection of utilities;
- 7 (3) repair and remedy suits;
- 8 (4) suits involving security deposits;
- 9 (5) suits involving unlawful lockouts;
- 10 (6) suits involving the provision of security and
- 11 safety devices; and
- 12 (7) any other category of suit involving a landlord or
- 13 tenant brought under Title 8, Property Code, and designated by the
- 14 council.
- 15 (b) The council may adopt rules as necessary to implement
- 16 this section.
- 17 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 18 of this Act, the Texas Judicial Council shall adopt any rules
- 19 necessary to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. (a) As soon as practicable after the effective
- 21 date of this Act the Texas Judicial Council shall prescribe the
- 22 categories of landlord and tenant suits a court is required to
- 23 report under Section 71.0354, Government Code, as added by this
- 24 Act, and the procedures for reporting under that section.
- 25 (b) Notwithstanding Section 71.0354, Government Code, as
- 26 added by this Act, a court is not required to report landlord and
- 27 tenant dispute information under that section until after the Texas

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- 1 Judicial Council establishes the categories and procedures for
- 2 reporting under that section.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
