A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the inclusion of certain information regarding trailers 3 in vehicle accident reports. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 201.806(a), Transportation Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The department shall: 8 (1) tabulate and analyze the vehicle accident reports 9 it receives; and annually or more frequently publish on 10 (2) the 11 department's Internet website statistical information derived from 12 the accident reports as to the number, cause, and location of highway accidents, including information regarding the number of: 13 14 (A) accidents involving injury to, death of, or property damage to a bicyclist or pedestrian; [and] 15 16 (B) fatalities caused by a bridge collapse, as defined by Section 550.081; and 17 18 (C) accidents involving a trailer, including the number of fatalities in those accidents. 19 SECTION 2. Section 550.064(b), Transportation Code, 20 is 21 amended to read as follows: 22 An accident report form prepared by the department must: (b) require sufficiently detailed information to 23 (1) disclose the cause and conditions of and the persons and vehicles 24

1 involved in an accident if the form is for the report to be made by a

3 (2) include a way to designate and identify a peace
4 officer, firefighter, or emergency medical services employee who is
5 involved in an accident while driving a law enforcement vehicle,
6 fire department vehicle, or emergency medical services vehicle
7 while performing the person's duties;

8 (3) require a statement by a person described by
9 Subdivision (2) as to the nature of the accident; [and]

10 (4) include a way to designate whether an individual 11 involved in an accident wants to be contacted by a person seeking to 12 obtain employment as a professional described by Section 38.01(12), 13 Penal Code; and

14 (5) include a way to indicate whether a trailer was 15 involved in the accident and, if so, whether the accident resulted 16 in any fatalities.
