Section 504.010, Transportation Code, is amended 4 5 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 6 7 (a) On payment of the prescribed fee, an applicant for motor vehicle registration shall be issued a license plate or set of 8 9 plates, provided that the department must issue a set of two plates to an applicant for registration of a passenger car or light truck. 10 (d) Rules adopted under Subsection (c) must authorize a 11 passenger car or light truck to display only a rear license plate if 12 the motor vehicle is not equipped by the manufacturer with an 13 14 exterior front feature to which a license plate may be fastened without drilling through the exterior of the vehicle. 15 SECTION 2. Section 504.943(a), Transportation Code, 16 is amended to read as follows: 17 18 (a) <u>A</u> [Except as provided by Subsection (b), a] person commits an offense if the person operates on a public highway, 19 during a registration period, a [motor] vehicle that does not 20 display all [two] license plates required by this chapter or a rule 21 adopted under this chapter to be displayed on the vehicle that: 22 23 (1) have been assigned by the department for the 24 period; and

(2) comply with department rules regarding the
placement of license plates.

3 SECTION 3. Section 504.943(b), Transportation Code, is 4 repealed.

SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 5 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 6 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 7 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 8 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 9 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 10 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 11 before that date. 12
