(e-7) If the commission, the department, or a child-placing 17 agency that contracts with the department has or obtains 18 information relating to the types of firearms and ammunition that 19 are present in an agency foster home, the commission, department, 20 or child-placing agency may not use that information for any 21 purpose other than determining whether there are firearms or 22 23 ammunition present in the home.
- 24 (e-8) A child-placing agency that violates Subsection (e-7)

- 1 <u>is liable to the state for a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed</u>
- 2 \$5,000 for each violation. The attorney general may bring an action
- 3 to recover a civil penalty authorized under this subsection.
- 4 (e-9) Information relating to the types of firearms and
- 5 ammunition that are present in an agency foster home is
- 6 confidential and is not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552,
- 7 Government Code.
- 8 (e-10) Subsections (e-6), (e-7), and (e-9) may not be
- 9 construed to limit the ability of the commission or a child-placing
- 10 agency to determine the presence of weapons and to verify the
- 11 appropriate storage of weapons in accordance with the standards
- 12 <u>adopted under Subsection (e-1).</u>
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
