5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2002, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2002.007 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2002.007. METAL ROOF COVERAGE. (a) In this section,
8	"residential property insurance" has the meaning assigned by
9	Section 2301.002.
10	(b) This section applies to each insurer that provides
11	residential property insurance in this state, including a county
12	mutual insurance company, farm mutual insurance company, Lloyd's
13	plan, and reciprocal or interinsurance exchange.
14	(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), an insurer may not
15	issue or renew a residential property insurance policy unless, if
16	applicable, the insurer provides coverage for damage to a metal
17	roof regardless of whether the damage impedes the function of the
18	roof.
19	(d) An insured may reject in writing the coverage required
20	by Subsection (c).
21	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
22	to a residential property insurance policy that is delivered,
23	issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2024.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
