- [provide that not more than 25 percent of training required every 8
- five years] include instruction regarding: 9
- (1) assisting students in developing high school 10 11 graduation plans;
- 12 (2) implementing dropout prevention strategies;
- 13 (3) informing students concerning:
- 14 (A) college admissions, including college
- financial aid resources and application procedures; and 15
- (B) career opportunities; 16
- 17 (4) counseling students concerning mental health
- 18 conditions and substance abuse, including through the use of
- grief-informed and trauma-informed interventions 19 and crisis
- 20 management and suicide prevention strategies; and
- 21 (5) effective implementation of a comprehensive
- 22 school counseling program under Section 33.005.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 23
- 24 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

5 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
