## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the deadline for an early voting ballot board to
- 3 determine whether to accept voters' ballots.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 65.051(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The early voting ballot board shall verify and count
- 8 provisional ballots as provided by this subchapter not later than
- 9 the 10th [ninth] day after the date of an election.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 87.041, Election Code, is amended by
- 11 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 12 (h) The early voting ballot board shall determine whether to
- 13 <u>accept mail ballots as provided by this section not later than the</u>
- 14 10th day after the date of an election.
- SECTION 3. Section 87.0431(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 (a) Not later than the 10th day after the local canvass
- 18 [election day], the presiding judge of the early voting ballot
- 19 board shall deliver written notice of the reason for the rejection
- 20 of a ballot to the voter at the residence address on the ballot
- 21 application. If the ballot was transmitted to the voter by e-mail
- 22 under Subchapter C, Chapter 101, the presiding judge shall also
- 23 provide the notice to the e-mail address to which the ballot was
- 24 sent.

1 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
