 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to prescription drug formularies applicable to the
 1-20 Medicaid managed care program.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 533.005(a-1), Government Code, is
 1-23 amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a-1) The requirements imposed by Subsections (a)(23)(A),
 1-25 (B), and (C) do not apply, and may not be enforced, on and after
 1-26 August 31, 2033 [~~2023~~].

1-27 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
 1-28 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
 1-29 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
 1-30 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
 1-31 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
 1-32 waiver or authorization is granted.

1-33 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
