5	SECTION 1. Section 81.01004, Natural Resources Code, is

7	Sec. 81.01004. PERSONAL FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE, STANDARDS OF

- 8 CONDUCT, [AND] CONFLICT OF INTEREST, AND RECUSAL. (a)
- 9 commissioner is subject to the provisions of Chapter 572,
- 10 Government Code, that apply to elected officers, including the
- 11 requirements governing personal financial statements, standards of
- 12 conduct, and conflicts of interest.
- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
- 14 commissioner may not act on a matter under the commission's
- 15 consideration that involves a business entity, as defined by
- 16 Section 572.002, Government Code:
- 17 (1) in which the commissioner has an equity ownership
- 18 <u>interest;</u>
- 19 (2) from which the commissioner receives income; or
- 20 (3) with which the commissioner has otherwise done
- 21 business in the preceding year in an amount of more than \$5,000,
- 22 including the making of consumer purchases.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
