16	are jointly entitled for that state fiscal year under any other law
17	that provides funding for the general maintenance and operation of
18	the system of public free schools, to comply with the minimum
19	requirement of Section 1, Article VII, Texas Constitution; or
20	(2) amounts greater than the amounts specified by
21	Subdivision (1).
