- 8 Sec. 1952.1061. NOTICE OF CLAIM FOR UNFAIR SETTLEMENT
- 9 PRACTICE. For the purpose of Section 541.060, an insured may
- 10 provide notice of a claim for uninsured or underinsured motorist
- 11 coverage by providing a written notification to the insurer that
- 12 reasonably informs the insurer of the facts of the claim.
- 13 Sec. 1952.1062. LEGAL DETERMINATION NOT PREREQUISITE TO
- 14 RECOVERY FOR UNFAIR SETTLEMENT PRACTICE. A judgment or other legal
- 15 determination establishing the other motorist's liability or the
- 16 extent of the insured's damages is not a prerequisite to recovery in
- 17 an action under Section 541.151 for a violation of Section 541.060
- 18 with respect to an uninsured or underinsured motorist claim.
- 19 Sec. 1952.1063. LIMITATION ON EXTRACONTRACTUAL CAUSES OF
- 20 ACTION. In regard to a claim for uninsured or underinsured motorist
- 21 coverage, the only extracontractual cause of action available to an
- 22 <u>insured is provided by Section 541.151 to recover damages under</u>
- 23 Section 541.152 for a violation of Section 541.060.
- SECTION 2. (a) Except as provided by this section, the

- 1 change in law made by this Act applies only to a cause of action that
- 2 accrues on or after the effective date of this Act. A cause of
- 3 action that accrues before the effective date of this Act is
- 4 governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that
- 5 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 6 (b) The change in law made by this Act does not affect the
- 7 enforceability of any provision in an insurance policy delivered,
- 8 issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2024, that
- 9 conflicts with the change in law made by this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
