## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the participation of community-based organizations in
- 3 workforce training programs funded by the skills development fund.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 303.003, Labor Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsection (h-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (h) A community-based organization may apply for money to
- 9 participate in a training program if:
- 10 <u>(1) the organization applies</u> [only] in partnership
- 11 with a community and technical college or the Texas A&M Engineering
- 12 Extension Service; or
- 13 (2) at least 90 days before the date the organization
- 14 applies, the organization submitted to a community and technical
- 15 college or the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service a written
- 16 request for a partnership with the college or service and has been
- 17 unable to obtain the partnership.
- 18 (h-1) If a [A] community-based organization that applies
- 19 <u>for funding under Subsection (h) provides</u> [<del>providing</del>] services
- 20 regulated by the state, the organization shall provide to the
- 21 commission evidence of any certification, license, or registration
- 22 required by law.
- 23 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 to an application for money from the skills development fund

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- 1 submitted to the Texas Workforce Commission on or after the
- 2 effective date of this Act. An application submitted before the
- 3 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 4 date the application was submitted, and the former law is continued
- 5 in effect for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
