## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility of certain volunteer firefighters and
- 3 paramedics for unemployment compensation benefits.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 201, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 201.079 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 201.079. SERVICE AS VOLUNTEER</u> FIREFIGHTER OR
- 8 PARAMEDIC. In this subtitle, "employment" does not include service
- 9 performed by an individual as a volunteer firefighter or paramedic
- 10 for which the only remuneration for the service is compensation for
- 11 not more than two 12-hour shifts each week, regardless of whether
- 12 the individual is certified to perform that service by an
- 13 appropriate entity.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a claim for unemployment compensation benefits that is filed
- 16 with the Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective date
- 17 of this Act. A claim filed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the claim was filed, and
- 19 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
