DISTRIBUTION OF LOW-INCOME VEHICLE REPAIR 8 ASSISTANCE, RETROFIT, AND ACCELERATED VEHICLE RETIREMENT PROGRAM 9 FUNDS. (a) This section applies only to a county that: 10 11 (1) is or was a participating county; and 12 (2) has remitted to the state fees collected for the low-income vehicle repair assistance, retrofit, and accelerated 13 14 vehicle retirement program. (b) Notwithstanding Sections 382.202(g), 382.209, and 15 382.220, not later than January 1, 2024, the commission shall 16 distribute to the counties described by Subsection (a) all 17 available money collected before September 1, 2023, under Section 18 382.202(e) or 382.302 that was designated for the low-income 19 vehicle repair assistance, retrofit, and accelerated vehicle 20 retirement program and is appropriated by the legislature for the 21 purposes described by this subsection. 22 23 (c) The commission shall distribute the money in reasonable

24 proportion to the amount of fees collected under Section 382.202(e)

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1	or 382.302 in those counties or in the regions in which those
2	counties are located.
3	(d) A county that receives money under this section may use
4	the money only to fund a program authorized by Section 382.220(b).

- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
