## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the persons entitled to request a public hearing from
- 3 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality related to the

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 382.058(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (c) For purposes of this section, only <u>a representative of a</u>
- 9 school, place of worship, licensed day-care center, hospital, or
- 10 medical facility or a person [those persons actually] residing [in
- 11 a permanent residence] within 440 yards of the proposed plant may
- 12 request a hearing under Section 382.056 as a person who may be
- 13 affected. The commission shall adopt rules establishing who
- 14 qualifies as a representative of a school, place of worship,
- 15 licensed day-care center, hospital, or medical facility under this
- 16 section.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an application for an authorization to use a permit that is
- 19 submitted to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on or
- 20 after the effective date of this Act. An application for an
- 21 authorization to use a permit that was submitted to the Texas
- 22 Commission on Environmental Quality before the effective date of
- 23 this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 24 application was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for

- 1 that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
