- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 33.027 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.027. PURCHASE OF LIBRARY MATERIALS FROM CERTAIN
- 8 VENDORS PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "obscene" has the meaning
- 9 <u>assigned by Section 43.21, Penal Code.</u>
- 10 (b) If a school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 11 determines that a material in the catalog of a school library of the
- 12 <u>district or school is obscene</u>, the district or school shall report
- 13 to the agency as soon as practicable the material and the vendor
- 14 from which the district or school purchased the material.
- 15 (c) The agency shall maintain on the agency's Internet
- 16 website a list of vendors reported to the agency under Subsection
- 17 (b). The agency shall update the list not later than the 30th day
- 18 after the date the agency receives a report under Subsection (b).
- 19 <u>(d) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may</u>
- 20 not purchase materials from a vendor on the list described by
- 21 Subsection (c).
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 23 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
