1-21 relating to the expiration of a protective order when the subject of  
 1-22 the protective order is confined or imprisoned.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 85.025, Family Code, is amended by  
 1-25 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-26 (d) As soon as practicable after the release of a person who  
 1-27 is the subject of a protective order from confinement or  
 1-28 imprisonment, the Department of Public Safety shall update the  
 1-29 statewide law enforcement information system maintained by the  
 1-30 department to reflect the date that the order will expire following  
 1-31 the person's release.

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 85.026, Family Code, is amended by  
 1-33 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

1-34 (d) Each protective order issued under this subtitle must  
 1-35 specify when the order expires and must provide notice of any  
 1-36 extensions that may apply to a person who is the subject of the  
 1-37 order, as a result of any confinement or imprisonment of that  
 1-38 person.

1-39 SECTION 3. Section 85.025(d), Family Code, as added by this  
 1-40 Act, applies only to a protective order with respect to a person who  
 1-41 is the subject of the order and who is released from confinement or  
 1-42 imprisonment on or after the effective date of this Act.

1-43 SECTION 4. Section 85.026(d), Family Code, as added by this  
 1-44 Act, applies only to a protective order issued on or after the  
 1-45 effective date of this Act.

1-46 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
