## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to preferential voting in runoff elections for certain
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 101.056, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) In addition to any other balloting materials provided to
- 8 the voter under this subchapter, the early voting clerk shall
- 9 provide the voter with:

voters voting by mail.

- 10 (1) a runoff election ballot for each office for which
- 11 the voter is eligible to vote, in accordance with Section 101.151;
- 12 <u>and</u>

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- 13 (2) a second carrier envelope in which the voter may
- 14 return the runoff election ballot.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 101.057, Election Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 17 (c) A runoff election ballot voted in accordance with
- 18 Section 101.151 may only be counted if a voter returns the ballot at
- 19 the same time and in the same manner as a general election ballot
- 20 voted by the voter under this subchapter.
- 21 SECTION 3. Chapter 101, Election Code, is amended by adding
- 22 Subchapter D to read as follows:
- 23 <u>SUBCHAPTER D. PREFERENTIAL VOTING IN RUNOFF ELECTION</u>
- Sec. 101.151. PREFERENTIAL VOTING IN RUNOFF ELECTION. (a)

- 1 A voter eligible for early voting by mail under this chapter shall
- 2 receive a runoff election ballot at the same time and in the same
- 3 manner as the voter's general election ballot.
- 4 (b) The secretary of state shall prescribe procedures to
- 5 provide for a runoff election ballot issued to a voter under this
- 6 chapter to use a preferential voting system. The system must allow
- 7 a voter to rank each candidate through a numerical designation from
- 8 the candidate the voter favors most to the candidate the voter
- 9 favors least.
- 10 (c) If a runoff election for any office voted by the voter
- 11 occurs, the carrier envelope containing the voter's runoff election
- 12 ballot shall be opened and the ballot shall be counted. The voter's
- 13 vote in the election is assigned to the runoff candidate whom the
- 14 voter assigned the highest favorable ranking on the runoff election
- 15 <u>ballot under Subsection (b).</u>
- 16 <u>(d) The secretary of state shall create detailed</u>
- 17 instructions on the use of a preferential voting system and provide
- 18 the instructions to each county clerk. A county clerk shall:
- 19 (1) post the instructions on the county clerk's public
- 20 Internet website, if the clerk maintains a website; and
- 21 (2) ensure that a copy of the instructions is mailed to
- 22 each voter who receives a runoff election ballot in the same time
- 23 and in the same manner as that ballot.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2023.
