## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to eligibility requirements under the owner-builder loan 3 program. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 2306.753(b), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) To be eligible for a loan under this subchapter, an owner-builder: 8 may not have an annual income that exceeds 80 [60] 9 (1)percent, as determined by the department, of the greater of the 10 state or local median family income, when combined with the income 11 12 of any person who resides with the owner-builder; 13 (2) must have resided in this state for the preceding 14 six months; (3) must have successfully completed an owner-builder 15 education class under Section 2306.756; and 16 17 (4) must agree to: (A) provide through personal labor at least 65 18 percent of the labor necessary to build or rehabilitate the 19 20 housing by working through a state-certified proposed 21 owner-builder housing program; 22 (B) provide of personal an amount labor 23 equivalent to the amount required under Paragraph (A) in connection with building or rehabilitating housing for others through a 24

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1 state-certified owner-builder housing program;

2 (C) provide through the noncontract labor of 3 friends, family, or volunteers and through personal labor at least 65 percent of the labor necessary to build or rehabilitate the 4 5 housing by working through proposed а state-certified owner-builder housing program; or 6

7 (D) if due to documented disability or other 8 limiting circumstances as defined by department rule the owner-builder cannot provide the amount of personal labor otherwise 9 10 required by this subdivision, provide through the noncontract labor of friends, family, or volunteers at least 65 percent of the labor 11 12 necessary to build or rehabilitate the proposed housing by working through a state-certified owner-builder housing program. 13

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
