- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 211.006(d), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) If a proposed change to a regulation or boundary is
- 8 protested in accordance with this subsection, the proposed change
- 9 must receive, in order to take effect, the affirmative vote of at
- 10 least three-fourths of all members of the governing body. The
- 11 protest must be written and signed by the owners of at least 50 [20]
- 12 percent of either:
- 13 (1) the area of the lots or land covered by the
- 14 proposed change; or
- 15 (2) the area of the lots or land immediately adjoining
- 16 the area covered by the proposed change and extending 200 feet from
- 17 that area.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to a proposal to change a municipal zoning regulation or zoning
- 20 district boundary made on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 A proposal to change a municipal zoning regulation or zoning
- 22 district boundary made before the effective date of this Act is
- 23 governed by the law in effect on the date the proposal was made, and
- 24 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
